 - i. The first PFAS test was complete and came back as "Non-detect"
 - ii. DEP-Monthly Reporting-deficient Chlorine Residuals
 - iii. Small Water Grant-Thomas Street PRV-Extension approved
 - iv. EPA Lead Service Line Inventory- we have over 1,100 properties inventoried and ready to be mapped. The initial inventory must be submitted to DEP by October 16th.
 - c. Sewer Plant/system
 - i. Preliminary design is complete with the drawings currently being reviewed by SMA internally. The final design has proceeded with final detailing and technical specifications in process. The WQM Part 2 Permit and Waterways and Wetlands Joint Permit Applications are currently being finalized and submission is anticipated within the next week.
 - ii. Following submission of the Part 2 Permit Application to DEP, SMA will continue to design the items that are not required to be in the permit application, including the ATAD and UV maintenance items. SMA will be in contact with the operator to discuss the UV upgrades to include only items necessary to maintain the system until the process upgrades are completed. SMA will also continue with the final design of the project to be ready for PennVEST funding submission in August (for the October funding meeting) or in November (for the January PennVEST meeting), depending on the permit review timeframe by DEP.
